Work Placement

It is compulsory to complete 120 hours (minimum 20 hours per week) of work placement within an aged care organisation. Work placement organisations will be introduced by Brighten Institute.

Work placement requirements:

- Up-to-date vaccinations (COVID-19, Current Influenza Vaccination)
- Clear and current National Police Check
